What do you believe are the key trends in the industry?

The main key trends we have noticed recently is an increased interest for environmentally friendly products and cleaning products which are cost effective in use. We have seen a huge increase in our Enviro chemical range which offers the user an effective, high concentrated cleaning product with the advantage of reduced packaging equating to lower emissions transporting goods. The range offers users reduced storage and cost savings using a concentrated and controlled dosage chemical.

Our recent catering catalogue has seen changes in this area, some of which include the replacement of plastic straws to paper, and the addition of a wider range of sustainable food packaging which is made from recycled paperboard material and is recyclable, biodegradable and compostable.

The Group Development Committee continually investigates innovations and trends within the market to ensure our product offering continues to grow with consideration to the impact of the environment as a forefront of its agenda.

What are the future plans for the business?

Although we are extremely proud of Jangro's past the group's focus is always on the future.
